**ORDER APPOINTING NEW MEMBERS TO THE LOCAL RULES COMMITTEE
FOR THE UNITED STATES BANKRUPTCY COURT FOR
THE DISTRICT OF DELAWARE**

On January 3, 2024, the United States District Court for the District of Delaware entered the *Order Appointing Local Rules Committee for the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware*. The Order appointed new members to the advisory committee (the “Local Rules Committee”) that studies the rules, practice, and internal operating procedures of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware (the “Court”) and makes recommendations concerning such rules and procedures. The Order also established six-year, staggered term limits for members of the Local Rules Committee and granted the Chief Judge of the Court authority to make future appointments to the Local Rules Committee and modifications to its structure and terms when necessary.

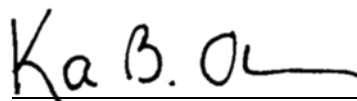
On February 1, 2026, the terms of Joseph M. Barry, L. Katherine Good, Marcos Ramos, and Eric J. Monzo as members of the Local Rules Committee expired. Therefore, it is necessary to appoint a new class of members to the Local Rules Committee with a six year term. Effective February 1, 2026, those new members and their respective class and term are:

In addition to the foregoing, Jane M. Leamy will replace Linda Richenderfer as the representative of the United States Trustee on the Local Rules Committee due to Ms. Richenderfer’s retirement. The remaining membership, classes, and terms of the Local Rules Committee remains unchanged.
